

INFORMATION FOR AUTHORS:

The “Ophthalmology” journal is a scientific-practical edition published in the Azerbaijan Republic. It publishes articles on different aspects of ophthalmology and other fields of medicine connected with it (neurosurgery, dentofacial surgery, immunology, etc.). The journal comes out 3 times a year. The articles are accepted in the Azerbaijan, Turkish, Russian and English languages.

While submitting the article the following requirements are to be observed:

1. Send the articles to the reduction of the journal to oftal.jurnal@mail.ru
2. The number of authors in one article is not to exceed 5 people.
3. Article is to be typed on a sheet of A4 format paper, Times New Roman, font size – 12, line interval – 1, margins: 3 cm offset on the left, 1 cm – on the right, 2 cm - up and down.
4. Volume of original articles including tables, images, literature and resume (0.5-1 page in the Azerbaijan/Russian and English languages) is not to exceed 6-8 pages, literature reviews – 10-12 pages, reports from practice – 3-5 pages.
5. Article must contain: a) family name(s) and initials of the author(s); b) title of the work in capital letters; c) name of the institution(s) where the work has been carried out, city, country; d) author’s e’mail; e) key words; f) UDC – universal decimal classification.
6. Article must be thoroughly checked and traditionally built including the following: introduction, aim of work, material and methods, discussions of results and conclusions. Summaries in different languages have to be the same and correspond to the article is content.
7. Tables and diagrams must be compact, visual, and have headings. Headings must fully correspond with their content. All figures in the tables must correspond to the figures in the text and must be statistically processed.
8. Only universally accepted abbreviations are accepted. When used for the first time reference designations of special terms must be fully written.
9. List of literature used is to be presented not in alphabetical order with family names and initials of the author(s), but in the sequence in which the sources are presented in the article. If there is repeated reference to some literary source it must be by the same number. All sources are to be enumerated and their enumeration must fully correspond to the enumeration in the text. Number of sources used is not to exceed 10-15 for original articles and 50 for literature reviews. If several works of the same author are quoted they are to be presented in chronological order. If there is a reference to the author's abstract of scientific paper the title is to be mentioned. In the literature list the reference is to be given to scientific works having been published for the last 5-10 years.
10. Articles previously published or sent for publication in other journals are not accepted.
11. Editorial staff has the right to abridge and make changes in the article.
12. Authors are responsible for authenticity of data in the article.
